

Seven restored aircrafts on loan from the U.S. Marine Corps and Department of Navy are on display, along with scaled models depicting the aircraft lineage of the 2D Marine Aircraft Wing at MCAS Cherry Point from its inception in 1942. Historic photographs and artifacts from Indian settlements to Civil War history round out the exhibit. 





Havelock is one of eight cities in the world named for Sir Henry Havelock, two of which are in Canada, three in the United States; one in Swaziland (Southern Africa) and two in New Zealand. An island in the Indian Ocean is also named for him. Settled before the Revolutionary War, Havelock welcomed the United States Marine Corps in 1940. Today, visitors are often seen craning their necks as Harriers or a Prowler streaks by overhead. Local residents are used to the roar acknowledged by a sign near the base's main gate, which reads: "Pardon our Noise; It's the Sound of Freedom."
