

Head to North Topsail Beach for fun in the sun or get on the water in the New River for fishing or kayaking.



### North Topsail Beach

Cross over the high-rise bridge and the Intracoastal Waterway to start your leisure vacation along the scenic shores of North Topsail Beach (NTB). Dogs are allowed and required to be kept on a 25-foot leash.



Onslow County Parks & Recreation offers parking along with restrooms and showers at no charge at three access points:

- Access #1 1795 New River Inlet Rd.
- Access #2 2950 Island Dr.
- Access #4 484 New River Inlet Rd.

The Town of NTB offers various paid parking accesses plus a 4x4 permissible driving area located at the north end of the island off River Road. Visitors must download the SurfCAST by Otto smartphone app to pay for a parking pass.

**Parking Rates:** Hourly \$5.00, Daily \$25.00, Weekly \$100.00, Annual \$250 – enforced from 9am to 5pm. More information can be found at www.ntbnc.org.

### **Onslow Beach**

Onslow Beach is located on Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune and open to all authorized DoD ID cardholders with proper base access. The beach features rental lodging units, an RV campground, pavilions with changing rooms, volleyball courts and guarded swimming areas from Memorial Day to Labor Day. # A hidden gem of natural and historic wonders

Feel the warm sunshine on your face and the tranquility that comes from being unplugged when you escape to the peaceful barrier island of Hammocks Beach State Park in Swansboro.



Your journey begins at the State Park Visitor Center where the exhibits tell the story of the park's 1,500-acres, which includes three smaller islands: Dudley, Huggins and Jones.

The park's crown jewel, Bear Island, was ranked as one of Travel + Leisure's Top Ten NC Beaches. You'll relish the "back to nature" vibe of this island that is free of cars and houses. Get there via the park's passenger ferry service that runs from April through October or with a specialty cruise operator offering eco-tours, shelling excursions and water taxi service.

Outdoor relaxation awaits on the wide uninterrupted beach. Enjoy a modest concession and picnic complex. Make your primitive camping or RV reservations on the park's website.

Explore the natural wonders of the unspoiled maritime forest on a kayak or paddleboard. Bring your own equipment or rent from the park's onsite outfitter, Paddle NC. Dolphins, sighting shorebirds and the occasional loggerhead sea turtle are some of the amazing experiences to enjoy on your own or on a guided tour.

We've got trails of all kinds. Hike the 3 miles of coastal wooded trails on the mainland. Read more about paddling and birding trails on pages 19-22.

Wildlife aficionados will appreciate the park's interpretive educational programs about ecology, endangered sea turtles and nesting shorebirds. Learn about the diverse history of the land from Native Americans and African Americans to pirates, farmers and the military.

### **Paddling & Birding Trails**

Paddling our waterways and discovering the many native species of birds and wildlife go hand-in-hand in Onslow County.

Hammocks Beach State Park is a great launch site to explore the three well-marked paddling trails leading to marshes, Bear Island or Huggins Island. Enjoy bird and wildlife sightings along the water surrounded by the unspoiled maritime forest. The trails range from 200 yards to more than 6 miles. Guided tours and rentals are available with Paddle NC.



The Cow Horn Trail is a 16.85mile trail that runs along the New River from Steeds Park in Richlands to the New River Waterfront Park in Jacksonville. North Topsail Beach's Permuda

Island Coastal Reserve is one of the best kayaking and stand-up paddle boarding (SUP) destinations in North Carolina. Kayak into the quiet waters of Stump Sound and get lost in the sights and sounds of the salt marsh. Enjoy calm waters and almost zero motorboat traffic.

### **Shrimping and Crabbing**

Join Captain Tommie Jarman owner of Reel Livin' Fishing Charters aboard his shrimp trawler in the fall season to learn about shrimping. This 4-hour journey along the New River offers breathtaking views, educational insights, and the chance to take home up to 50 lbs. of freshly caught shrimp and crabs.



### **Biking and Walking Trails**

Scenic routes and fun trails are available for cyclists and walkers of all levels to enjoy. From flat, shaded trails to long distance routes, Onslow County offers miles of trails winding within the city of Jacksonville and stretching all the way to the coast.

• **Big Branch Bike Park** - 1.6 mile flow trail and a 4.6 mile intermediate mountain bike trail in Jacksonville. Great greenway loop trails for all levels.

• Rails to Trails Greenway - 6 mile trail through Jacksonville. With no cars around, this is great for beginners.

• **Richlands Loop Trail** - 50 mile and shorter 20 mile road loop that runs through rural coastal plains of Onslow County.

• Hammocks Beach State Park - 3 mile woodland trail for walking. Plus, explore Bear Island's shoreline to find seashells and enjoy the ocean sounds.



### NC Mountains-to-Sea Trail

The NC Mountains-to-Sea Trail is as diverse as North Carolina, traversing 1,175 miles across our

# WELCOME TO Jacksonville, MC

Welcome to our proud city located on the banks of the New River and home to US Marine Corps Base Camp Lejeune. Plan a relaxing getaway with us and you are guaranteed a refreshing escape where you'll experience mouthwatering meals, exciting recreational opportunities, and historic monuments honoring our military heritage.

### Get on the water

Grab a kayak at one of our three rental kiosks located at Jacksonville Landing, Northeast Creek Park or the Riverwalk Marina and explore one of nine blueway trails. Enjoy dock side fishing at one of our many access points in beautiful parks. Make sure to check with the NC Wildlife Commission for licensing and regulations. Spend the day casting for fun with one of our fishing guides. They provide everything.

### **Explore the greenways**

Ride your bikes or take a walk on miles of trails to enjoy the outdoors (and possibly spot a rare bird or two). The NC Mountains-to-Sea Trail is North Carolina's state hiking trail stretching from the Great Smoky Mountains to the Outer Banks. You'll find a section of the trail runs right through the center of Jacksonville.

### Western Boulevard

Stay at one of our attractively priced brand name hotels, dine at familiar chains or experience a cultural local restaurant, and shop your way through the many retail stores along Jacksonville's main strip, Western Boulevard.

### Enjoy family time

Take in the outdoors at one of our many parks and trails. Walk the labyrinth or catch a show at the amphitheater at Richard Ray Park. A night at the ballpark is always a hit. Catch a Jacksonville Ospreys Baseball game during their summer season, late May – July.



## See Ospreys in nests and in the sky

Pause when you hear the rumbling of the MV-22 Osprey flying overhead. With the ability to fly like a plane and take off and land like a helicopter, this aircraft was largely developed in

Jacksonville. When near the water's edge, you may catch a flash of live osprey (a large hawk that lives near the water) diving into the river or sound for a fish. Onslow County boasts one of the highest concentrations of ospreys of either kind on the eastern seaboard.







### Visit our historical memorials

Each memorial connects the story of our country to this city and American life today. Appreciation for the sacrifices of our service men and women (and their families) come to life when you listen to the audio tour as you walk the winding paths through Lejeune Memorial Gardens.

### **Beirut Memorial**

The Beirut Memorial is a solemn tribute to the 273 Marines who gave the last full measure of devotion



in Lebanon and Grenada on October 23, 1983. The names of each man are engraved in granite along with the words "They Came In Peace". Each year, a Remembrance Observance takes place on October 23 to remember those who gave the greatest sacrifice for their country.

### **Corpsmen Memorial**

The Corpsmen Memorial is a tribute of the lasting bond between Marines and Corpsmen both on and off the battlefield. The memorial honors the fallen, but also stands as a monument to Corpsmen of the present and future.

### **Vietnam Veterans Memorial**

This memorial honors all the service men and women who served in the Vietnam War. It is the second largest Vietnam Veterans Memorial in the nation. The dome and fountain are surrounded with a glass wall with the names of 58,220 lost Americans etched in the glass in alphabetical order.



### **Montford Point Marine Memorial**

The Montford Point Marine Memorial, the only one in the nation, is dedicated to the legacy of 20,000 African American Marines who served in the Marine Corps from 1942-1949 under harsh conditions, and separate from their white counterparts. The story is told through architecture and sculpture.

### 9/11 Memorial Beam

Delivered by a New York City Fire Truck, this beam from the Twin Towers was presented by police and firefighters of New York to Camp Lejeune in 2003.

### Eagle, Globe, and Anchor Reflection Pool

The statue is located at the entryway to the future Museum of the Marine and is the largest 3-D representation of the Eagle, Globe and Anchor statue in the world. Each star on the globe represents places where Marines have routinely deployed.


