Hook a catch at the Kure Beach Fishing Pier, one of the oldest piers on the East Coast. Head to Fort Fisher State Recreation Area to soak up some sun on the beach, spot shore birds, or hike maritime forest trails at the sanctuary for wildlife and outdoor enthusiasts.

Come face-to-face with wonders of the underwater world at The North Carolina Aquarium at Fort Fisher. When you see alligators, sharks, stingrays, seahorses, sea you'll see why Travel Channel named the aquarium among the best in the country.

Tour sacred grounds and the largest earthen fort in the South at Fort Fisher State Historic Site, where the largest land-sea battle of the Civil War occurred. If you're up for a dive, explore North Carolina's first heritage dive site and shipwreck, the Civil War Blockade Runner *The Condor*.

Family events abound on Kure Beach. All visitors can enjoy free Boogie in the Park concerts, Storytime by the Sea, Turtle Talks, and other family events at the Ocean Front Park throughout the summer.


